

Joining the PrOsnuvo™ Patient Care Program



AVIR Pharma Inc. is pleased to introduce the **Osnuvo Patient Care Program ("Program")**. A caseworker will be available to support patients starting **Osnuvo** therapy by offering reimbursement navigation, financial support, and injection training. By providing assistance, AVIR is helping to ensure that patients with **Osnuvo** prescriptions have access to this important medication.



Please note, every **Osnuvo** patient must enroll in the Program to receive the required administration device called a TERROSA® pen. The patient may choose the service(s) which they will benefit from, and can cancel the enrolment and revoke consent at any time.

What can I expect?

When you enroll in the Program, you will be asked a few questions to determine the level of reimbursement assistance and financial support you qualify for. Once enrolled, you will be assigned a Client ID number which will be linked to your level of financial support. You will receive further instructions in your welcome communication.

How do I enroll?

- 1 Please call 1-888-303-8702 between Monday to Friday, 8 am-8 pm (EST).
- 2 A caseworker will enroll you into the Program over the phone. This call may take approximately 15-30 minutes.
- 3 Once the enrollment is completed, you will receive a welcome communication with further details about the Program and services available to you along with your Client ID.

Some medications require prior approval by insurers. Your caseworker will be able to assist you in determining whether your insurer requires it and help you navigate this process.

What do I need to know about injection training?

To self-administer **Osnuvo**, you will need an administration device called a TERROSA® pen, which is provided to you free of charge. Once your enrollment is completed, a caseworker will contact you to schedule your injection training with a registered nurse. You will be given the option of in-clinic training or virtual training. Based on the type of training you choose, you will receive a TERROSA® pen either:

- in person on the day of your in-clinic visit or,
- by mail prior to your virtual training.

Important Information for Physicians:

- The patient's insurance provider may request prior authorization for **Osnuvo**. A caseworker may contact you regarding necessary information and submission of the form. To help ease the process, we suggest that you provide your patient with all the relevant information.
- To ensure your patient receives injection training, please fax a copy of their **Osnuvo** prescription to STI Technologies at 1-833-455-0972.

Program Details:

Your patient will have access to a variety of services, such as: reimbursement navigation support, financial assistance, and injection training. Furthermore, the caseworkers remain available to assist you in completing any prior authorization or special authorization requests.
